- REALITY- After spending \$243 they will probably be thrown away!



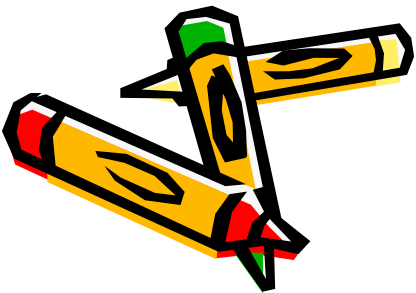
Still Not Convinced

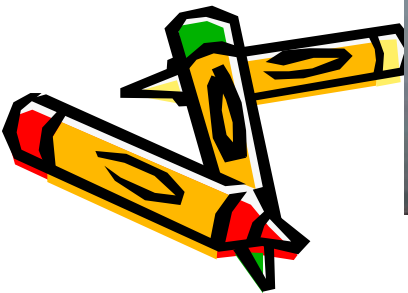
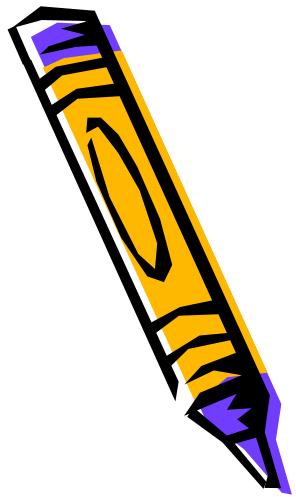
